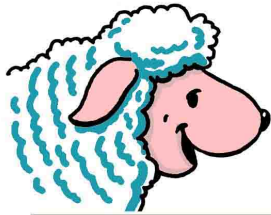

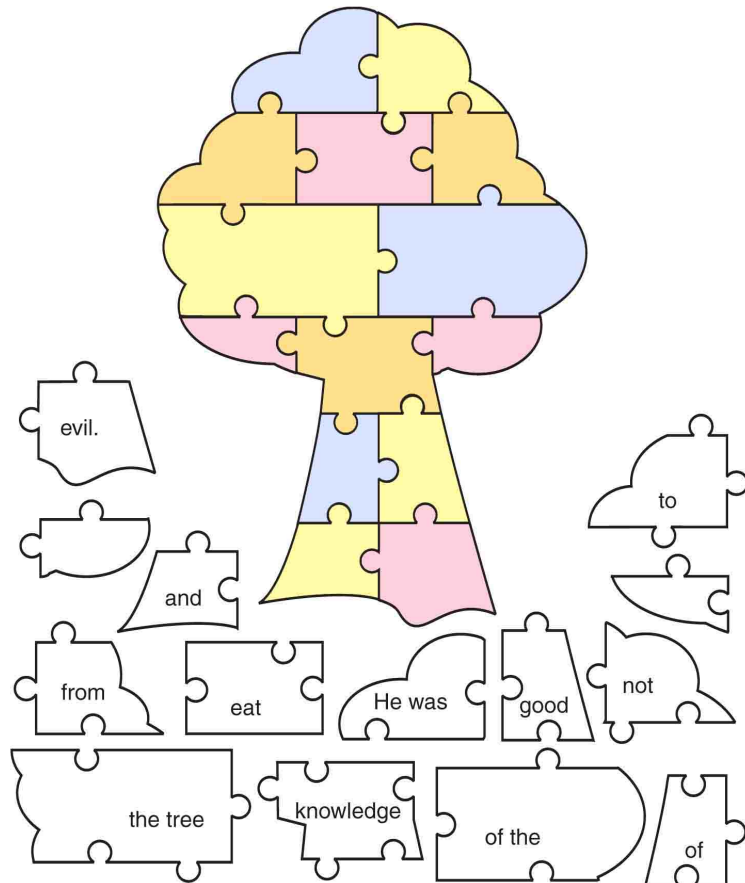

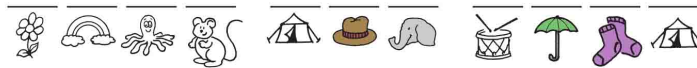


On the 6th day of creation God formed man. The man was named Adam. The woman was named Eve.
